

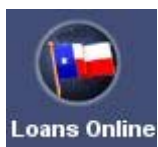
Hinson-Hazlewood College Access Loan Application Process

Texas Tech is participating in a new electronic application process for the College Access Loan program. The electronic application, ECAL, allows the student to apply for a College Access Loan on-line. Once the application is completed, the borrower will be directed to print a promissory note, provide the required signatures, and send the promissory note to the Coordinating Board. Texas Tech University will go on-line and certify the application based on the student's eligibility for financial aid. This new on-line process greatly reduces time for approval and disbursement of funds.

The student borrower should select the EFT option on the application to have their loan funds electronically disbursed to Texas Tech University. This option will aid TTU in disbursing funds to the student on a faster basis. Students can elect to have their refund check sent to a checking or savings account through Direct Deposit by contacting Student Business Services at www.sbs.ttu.edu.

Just follow the steps below to apply for a College Access Loan on Line:

1. Via the internet, enter www.hhloans.com. Select "Loans Online".



2. You will next be viewing the Loan Programs Online page. Under Loan Programs, select "College Access Loan Program (CAL)" and then follow the application instructions.
3. When you are requested to select a school in the application process, be sure to select **Texas Tech University (Fice Code 003644)** as the school to receive your application information.
4. Texas Tech University will review applications pending certification at least once per week.
